



**MOUNTVIEW WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND
HUNTSVILLE SEWAGE WORKS UPGRADES
CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT
NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #2**

The District Municipality of Muskoka (The District) is carrying out a new Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to identify an updated Preferred Solution for replacing the Mountview Wastewater Treatment Plant and improving sewage works in the Town of Huntsville for the future. This study is proceeding as a Schedule C project under the Municipal Engineers Association's (MEA) *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* document (October 2000 as amended). The District hosted Public Information Centre (PIC) #1 on February 24th, 2014 to provide an opportunity for interested members of the public to learn about the project and to give input on the Problem/Opportunity Statement as well as possible Alternative Solutions for this Class EA. The District is hosting PIC #2 to present the Alternative Solutions that have been developed through investigation and consultation with interested stakeholders and the public. The proposed criteria for evaluating Alternative Design Concepts for implementing the Preferred Solution will be presented to allow an understanding of the evaluation and assessment process.
